Most Body & Blood of Christ June 2, 2013

First Reading Genesis 14:18-20
Psalm 110 "You are a priest for ever, in the line of Melchizedek."
Second Reading 1 Corinthians 11:23-26
Gospel: Luke 9:11b-17
Jesus' words "This is my body" and "This cup is the new covenant in my blood" were only part of his table blessing. He also said, twice, "Do this in remembrance of me." From the Desk of the Pastor....



The Doctrine of Trinity is defined by the Church as the belief that in God are three persons who subsist in one nature. The doctrine was defined only in the 4th and 5th centuries and hence is not explicitly and formally a biblical belief. In the unfolding of the doctrine of the Trinity, the church owes a lot to Tertullian who introduced three important words into the Trinitarian language. First of all, it is Tertullian who invented the word Trinity, which since his time has become so characteristic a feature of Christian Theology. Second, he introduced the word person, persona in Latin, which literally means a mask, worn by an actor in a Roman drama. It is quite possible that Tertullian wanted his readers to understand the idea of one substance, three persons to mean that the one God played three distinct yet related roles in the drama of human redemption. Behind the plurality of roles lay a single actor. Thirdly, Tertullian introduced the term substance to express the idea of a fundamental unity within the Godhead. Substance is what the three persons of the Trinity have in common. It expresses their common foundational unity, despite their outward appearance of diversity.

Our redemption is thus the result of the three persons of the Godhead acting in distinct yet coordinated manner in human history, without any loss of the total unity of the Godhead. For us, Trinity is a revelation that says God is a relationship, the relations between the Father God, Son God, and Spirit God. Each person in the Trinity is different from the other. And yet the three exist as one God, all three form one God. In the same way, human life is put together in a pattern of differences and unity. Each individual is different, but there exists a unity in this diversity. Each living and non-living things in the nature has its identity, individuality, but it is part of a unity, a part of this larger universe. The life and existence that we and the created things of this world enjoy is a projection and reflection of the very same life in the Trinity.
