The Archdiocese has been serving a mission Church in Venezuela for 50 years!



Fr. Tim Norris, representing our Archdiocesan mission parish in Venezuela, will present our annual mission appeal on the weekend of September 4/5. The Archdiocese of St. Paul and Minneapolis has had a unique relationship with the Diocese of Ciudad Guayana since 1970 sending our archdiocesan priests to serve parishes there. Today, our priests serve the parish of Jesucristo Resucitado in San Felix. This diocese suffers from 70% unemployment and a lack of healthcare and basic nutrition. Fr. Norris will speak about the work of the mission and the needs of the poor and needy within the 11 barrios of the parish. He will be seeking our financial support for this mission of evangelization, lifting human dignity and giving opportunities for growth.

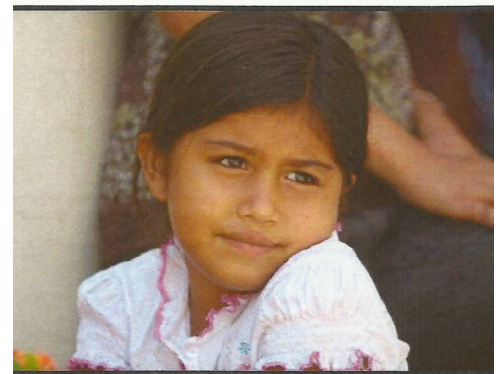
