The monthly meeting of the St. Patrick Parish Pastoral Council (PPC) was called to order at 6:35 p.m. by Chairman Sharon Kaisershot who also led us in prayer. Wayne Velishek moved to accept the agenda. It was seconded by George Sticha and the motion Passed. Doug Knutson moved to approve the February 16, 2017 PPC minutes. **Pastor Report:** Father Victor is on medical leave for a couple months.

### Standing Reports:

**Building Committee/Maintenance/ Grounds Report:** Harry Redman reported that #2 Heat Exchanger went out at a Saturday Mass. He got it working. A tree blew down across the road. It is being taken care of. Olympic Fire Protection says that we may need to change out our sprinkler heads. Nothing has been mentioned in by our insurance provider so we will contact them.

**Cemetery Report:** John McDonough reported there were no burials. At a Catholic Cemeteries meeting he found out that the more cemeteries are requiring a vault for urns.

**CCW Report:** No report as June Malecha was not present.

**Faith Formation Report:** Tracy Velishek reported that Marriage In Christ program began on February 26<sup>th</sup> for 5 weeks with 4 couples signed up. Faith Focus is taking a break. Food For Kids raised \$3,050 (\$50 over goal). Top Fundraising Youth fundraising individuals will be treated to a pizza party. Our Music Director, Alissa Simones provide contemporary music at the event. Youth reconciliation was March 8<sup>th</sup> and the parish is April 3<sup>rd</sup>. We have 4 students and 2 chaperones going to the Steubenville Conference in Rochester, MN this coming July.

**Finance Committee Report:** Harry Redman that our finances are good. The Finance Council agreed to move some money into a 'Future Maintenance' Account. If you know of items that need to be done, replaced or added, please contact him. Work on the parish house is pretty much done except for purchasing a new AC unit. Harry also reported that he found out the Archdiocese will be requiring a depreciation schedule in 2018 in order to qualify for the Pace/Prism rebate. We received \$1,987 for our involvement in the Pace/Prism last year. Doug Knutson requested that the Catholic Services Appeal information be included in the bulletin so people can see how much has been contributed.

**Liturgy/Music Report:** Sharon Kaisershot reported that we are getting ready for Easter

Father Victor has gotten the commitment of a concert pianist and a tenor to sing, Lakeside Supper Club (George Kukacka) will do the food. Tickets are \$40. Father Victor wants to sell 350 tickets.
