We often hear people complaining that they are misunderstood. If we are misunderstood it can be that people are either given wrong information about us or that they choose to behave that way deliberately. In the final analysis what we learn is that we experience prejudices in our day-to-day human inter-relationships or contacts.

It is unchristian to be prejudiced against anybody for any reason. To be prejudiced is to violate the very teaching of Christ. Jesus taught love, mercy, compassion, understanding and forgiveness. Everything He taught was chiefly centered around one single theme: Love. It is not the kind of love that most people abuse for their own selfish motives. But it is the love that pours out a spirit of compassion and supplication on us. It is the love that proceeds from God who is love. Love is a fountain that is opened for us by Christ to cleanse us from sin and impurity.

This world is desperate to experience the love and compassion of God. More than any other human attribute, I believe our world is crying out for people with compassion, people who love unconditionally, people who will take some time to understand others, to help their fellow sojourners on this planet. Instead of judging and condemning people, simply have an ear to listen. You don't have to know all the answers.
