First Reading: Wisdom 1:13-15; 2:23-24
Psalm 30 "I will praise you, Lord, for

you have rescued me."

Second Reading: 2 Corinthians 8:7,9, 13-15

Gospel: Mark 5:21-43

These readings address sickness and death. The first reading speaks of death entering the world at the hand of the devil. The Gospel features a dying girl and an ill woman. But sickness and death do not have the last word. Not with God, for God made us that we may have life. Both the girl and the woman are cured. Thus, we can sing, as we do in the psalm, "I will praise you, Lord, for you have rescued me."

A Word from Father Victor ...

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

June 24 is a day we remember the important role of St. John the Baptist in the story of the life of Jesus and in our story of Salvation. It happens to be Sunday and we get the opportunity to celebrate it as a community. He was a relative and a precursor of Jesus. He preached a baptism of repentance and lived a very simple and faithful life.

In my home country we celebrate this day going to the beach and get wet. Some people would be on the streets bringing a pail of water and wet people. The tradition is not just about having fun with water but with water we remind each other of our special calling and identity as we were baptized with water.

First it is about a call to a baptism of cleansing. By water we are cleansed/freed from sin. By water we are marked with the special identity as children of God and brothers and sisters of our Lord Jesus Christ. By this water therefore, we must always be conscious that we must live as children of God. In this water we remember we experience the cleansing of our hearts from sin and the loving mercy and forgiveness of God. It is our calling to live out our identity and to share his word to others.

Pope Paul VI said in his papal encyclical *Evangelii Nuntiandi* "those who have received the good news and who have been gathered by it into the community of salvation, can and must communicate and spread it.". Like Isaiah, Paul and John, we are clear of our mission: all the baptized have the responsibility in participating in the Jesus' mission.

Remembering St. John the Baptist affirms is of our vocation to live a life in which others can recognize that Jesus is Lord!
