The monthly meeting of the St. Patrick Parish Pastoral Council (PPC) was called to order at 6:35 p.m. by Chairman Sharon Kaisershot. Father Valencia led us in prayer. Doug Knutson moved to accept the agenda with additions. It was seconded by Wayne Velishek and the motion Passed. Doug Knutson moved to approve the April 21, 2016 PPC minutes. Pastor Report: Father Valencia updated us on his need for a kidney transplant due to kidney failure related to diabetes. The 3 month process has begun and he hopes to be on the kidney transplant list by mid June. As soon as he is on the list, he will open up the search for a donor.
