The monthly meeting of the St. Patrick Parish Pastoral Council (PPC) was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Chairman Doug Knutson. Fr. Victor led us in prayer. Wayne Velishek moved to approve the June agenda and June Malecha made the second. Jason Sanborn moved to approve the May secretary minutes with one correction. June Malecha seconded.

Chairman Knutson reported there were no comments or suggestions to be read.

Grand Party Chairs Randy & Kathy Archambault were present. 18 tickets were left. The committee will be looking for a new band as Downtown Sound will be disbanding. Jason Sanborn moved to hire the Delcount Band. Tracy Velishek made the second. Father Victor would like to make it a family event with tickets remaining at \$60 per couple and \$5 for kids. Dance only tickets would be \$10 and 225 tickets will be sold for the May 19, 2019 event.

Pastor Report: Fr. Victor reported he called seven nominees for the PPC Election. Two responded, Mark Lessman and Denise Flicek. They will be appointed to the open positions. Father renamed the parish directory "Celebrating Faith" and has requested we do our own cover. He requested we set a 'Ministry Day' as a day of appreciation for our parish ministries. Invitations will be sent for social hour and dinner on May 3, 2019.

Standing Committee Reports:

Building Committee/Maintenance/ Grounds Report: The sprinkler system has been tested. Hail damaged siding on the rectory has been replaced

Cemetery Report: Cemetery is very wet and burials will be limited at this time.

CCW Report: June Malecha reported the CCW purchased a new grill and bed for the rectory.

Faith Formation Report: No report. Father Victor would like a year-end report of all activities, attendance numbers and confirmation students. He wants a marketing program for Religious Ed.

Finance Committee Report: Harry Redman reported that the Finance Committee approved the 2018/2019 Budget at their June 14th meeting. The budget will be sent to the PPC in July for approval.

Liturgy/Music Report: Sharon Kaisershot reported that we will participate in the Trebon Mass. Father Victor would like to see all new members recognized at the Fall Festival..

Unfinished Business:

- Jason Sanborn received quotes for a mounted, stationary and rotating cameras for Mass, weddings and other Masses. We will need new wireless microphones by 2020. We need to use Facebook to post and promote church activities. 1526 people viewed our Facebook page last month and 769 engaged it.
- Father Victor would like to revise our bulletin. The security system work is still in progress. Final plans for Father Victor's 25th Anniversary were tabled until the March meeting.

New Business:

- The PPC will host a Fellowship Hour after Mass on July 29, 2018. Coffee and cookies will be served in the narthex. New PPC members will be commissioned on July 8, 2018 at 9 a.m. Mass. The Council thanked Mary Kay Reynolds and Wayne Velishek for their service.
