First Reading: Genesis 2: 7-9, 3: 1-7

Psalm 51 "Be merciful, O Lord, for we have sinned."

Second Reading: Romans 5: 12-19

Gospel: Matthew 4: 1-11

The "HRS Makeover Campaign" is underway and is part of the school's effort to increase enrollment. This week you will receive a letter describing the need for HRS to update its facilities and explaining how you can help the school achieve its goals. As previously shared, HRS participated in a marketing study to learn how the community views the current school. For the most part, parents and families express satisfaction with the education that students receive, and that's great. However, another consensus view was that, in some areas, the school appears old and outdated and has a "definite 1980s feel." In short, HRS needs to

improve its "curb appeal" if we wish to attract new students. Needed facility upgrades will include updated furniture, new paint, and modern lighting. Improving the school's appearance may also involve moving current offices and classrooms to better suit school needs. The good news is that HRS has secured a matching grant with Catholic Schools of Excellence (CSCOE). Expressly, CSCOE will donate \$50,000 to HRS IF the school can match the CSCOE donation with the same amount. The school has already received \$15,000 dedicated for use on upgrades. That means that HRS must raise the remaining \$35,000 in order to qualify for the grant. Obviously, CSCOE's willingness to donate \$50,000 in matching funds is a vote of confidence for our school and would--combined with our own funds--give us \$100,000 to finance improvements. Again, this week, HRS stakeholders will receive a letter asking for donations to the "HRS Makeover Campaign." Please support the cause. If you want to help even before receiving that fundraising request, please call the school at 507-364-7383. We'd love to share our excitement about this important effort. Have a good week.
