First Reading: Sirach 15: 15-20

Psalm 119 "Blessed are they who follow the law of the Lord!"

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 2: 6-10

Gospel: Matthew 5: 17-37

In the first reading, Sirach teaches us that we have the ability to choose between right & wrong. Choosing to trust in God & to keep the commandments is the way to salvation. Jesus extends the commandments when speaking to his disciples, telling them that they must do more.
