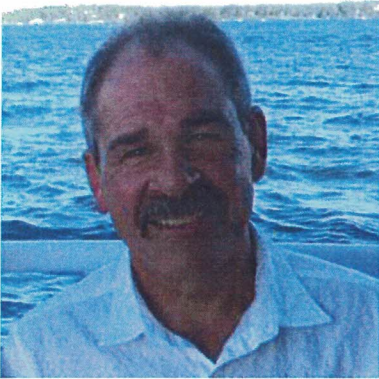


St. Patrick Parish Pastoral Council Elections

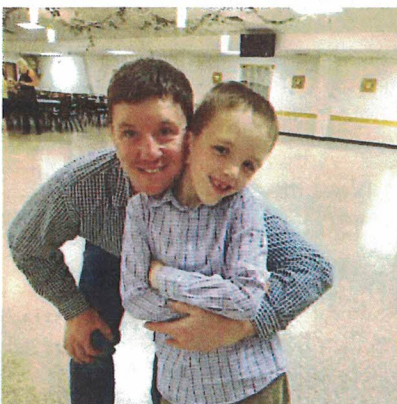
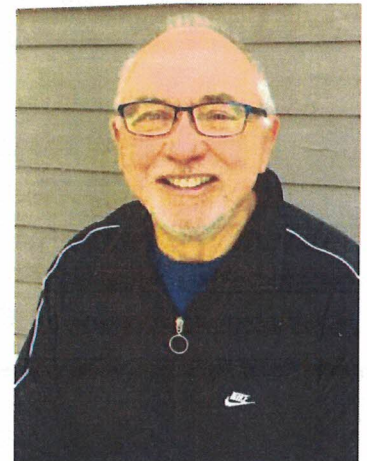
