First Reading: Isaiah 60: 1-6

Psalm 72 "Lord, every nation on earth will adore you."

Second Reading: Ephesians 3: 2-3a, 5-6

Gospel: Matthew 2: 1-12

A light shines for all to see, revealing God's glory and drawing people from all over. In Isaiah the light is in Jerusalem, the holy city, attracting kings and caravans. 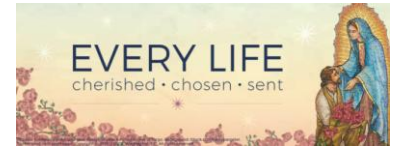
## Sunday Funday
