"Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood dwells in me and I in him." Absence, alienation, loneliness and communication gaps are the ailments of modern life. We yearn for presence and the loving care of a person who is close by. The great consolation that Christianity offers to mankind haunted by the threat of alienation is that God is close by in Jesus Christ. Jesus is present in his church, especially in the Liturgical celebrations. He is present in the Sacrifice of Mass. By his power he is present in the Sacraments. He is present in the word when the Holy Scriptures are read to us. He is present when the Church prays and sings. In today's Gospel, we have reference to how the early church and the Lord Jesus himself saw the Eucharistic Banquet. "Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood dwells in me and in him"-Jesus says. By his mysterious presence in the Eucharist our Lord heals the wounds caused by absence and alienation.

People are hungry not only for food but for companionship, friendship, fellowship, love, intimacy, joy, peace, compassion and forgiveness. They are hungry for God and spirituality. And these are the hungers that are satisfied by the bread that Jesus promises. These hungers are not satisfied by our society's fast food mentality. We come to this Eucharistic table not to fill our stomach or satisfy our physical hunger. By eating from this table we come to know the Lord and one another. And we become attentive to each others hunger for friendship and companionship, compassion and forgiveness. We find our satisfaction of these hungers at this table of the Lord.
