First Reading: Jeremiah 23:1-6  
Psalm 23 "The Lord is my shepherd, there is nothing I shall want".  
Second Reading: Ephesians 2:13-18

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

May I invite you to reflect with me Jesus' invitation "to take nothing in the journey" as his disciples. IN three days I will leave for month long vacation to my birth place with my family. I am not a light traveler and so you can imagine me with two fifty pound boxes and a suitcase!

Of course I am checking them in as baggage and not as a carry on. If there is excess baggage I'd rather pay than carry it. But for emotional baggage we can not pay to not carry it. We have to carry the weight of it in our lives and sometimes they can be a real burden that it can affect our way of living.

Jesus is inviting his disciples not to carry a "baggage" in the ministerial journey. How do we do this? God said to Paul in last week's scripture reading: "my grace is sufficient for you". To face our emotional baggage can be unpleasant and painful. WE will have to confront ourselves with our painful baggage and heal from it. That can put us in a very uncomfortable and vulnerable position. But that's the way to healing and well being. That is what Jesus want us to do as his disciples. To be able to listen and offer a compassionate hand to others, first we have to do it for ourselves. WE can bring about healing when we are healed. The forgiveness of others are brought about from the fact that giver has also experienced forgiveness and redemption. Can we remember our experience of forgiveness from God?
